HOUSING HELP

But we will provide access to a platform where, upon acceptance, students can communicate with each other and work together to arrange housing if they wish to. We do suggest that you use practical wisdom in taking steps to secure an adequate living situation, by choosing something within your budget, that is a reasonable distance from the school and, if you are moving in with roommates or renting a room from someone, we suggest that you meet with the person(s) and see the room or house prior to signing any agreements. Technology offers many video solutions to accomplish this if it is not possible to do so in person.

APPROX. 1-8 MILES FROM WHERE JESUS CULTURE SACRAMENTO IS BASED

Folsom is a relatively large city and is known to be very family friendly. It has many outdoor activities, a quaint historic downtown and a thriving cyclist community. It is right off of Highway 50 and is where the JC Sacramento local church meets on Sundays. Folsom Lake is also located here and is great for water sports, as well as Lake Natoma for kayaking or paddle boarding. There are also lots of parks and trails to bike or walk.

ORANGEVALE

APPROX. 3-12 MILES FROM WHERE JC SACRAMENTO IS BASED

Orangevale is known for its rolling hills that offer the best views of the Sierra Nevada mountain range, its foothills, and a rural environment in the middle of a growing metropolitan area. It is a few miles west of Folsom and is a smaller, more rural community. Orangevale has some great nature spots, and parks that offer horse arenas and disc golf.

GOLD RIVER

APPROX. 7-13 MILES FROM WHERE JC SACRAMENTO IS BASED

MIDTOWN

APPROX. 20-26 MILES FROM WHERE JC SACRAMENTO IS BASED

Midtown is a largely residential community with tree-lined streets and old Victorians. It is also the center of Sacramento's art, music, and cultural scene. Boutiques, bars, clubs, upscale, and casual dining abound. Historic sites such as Sutter's Fort, the first European settlement in Sacramento, are located in Midtown. Midtown is known for being pedestrian-friendly and bike-friendly with continuous marked bike lanes throughout the neighborhood and a bike path connecting to the American River Parkway which extends to Folsom.

SACRAMENTO

APPROX. 24-30 MILES FROM WHERE JC SACRAMENTO IS BASED

Sacramento is the Capital of California and is rich in culture and history. It is a great option for those interested in a "city" experience, and is also known as the City of Trees. There are plenty of great restaurants and interesting sites such as the State Capitol building, museums, and the Golden One Center where sports, concerts and other events continually take place.
